



"Every time we came close to a protected area, we found the same story: forest-dependant communities, who had been managing and co-existing with their ancestral forests sustainably for generations, had seen their lands and primary sources of livelihoods and income stripped away by protected areas that were imposed on them without their consent.

....[...] side-lined in the management of the forests they depend on, and having to endure heavy-handed enforcement of rules that were not properly explained to them, with armed park rangers arbitrarily and disproportionately targeting them for 'poaching' instead of going after the real criminals."

The World Wide Fund for Nature funds vicious paramilitary forces to fight poaching. A BuzzFeed News investigation reveals the hidden human cost.



Chitwan National Park, Nepal Salonga National Park, DR Congo Lobéké National Park, Cameroon Kaziranga National Park, India "Indigenous groups living near Chitwan [Nepal] have long detailed a host of abuses by these forces. Villagers have reported beatings, torture, sexual assaults, and killings by the park's guards. They've accused park officials of confiscating their firewood and vegetables, and forcing them into unpaid labor."

"Indigenous people living near one park in southeast **Cameroon** described a litany of horrors in interviews and documents obtained by BuzzFeed News: dead-of-night break-ins by men wielding machetes, rifle butt bludgeonings, burn torture involving chilis ground into paste, and homes and camps torched to the ground."
