- SALW and SGBV in times of peace


Impact of armed violence and conflict

Adjusted net enrolment ratio in primary school for girls, 2013




CHILD MARRIAGE







Where are the Women?

In peace processes between 1992 and 2011 women were:


2% of Chief Mediators


Women's movement towards UNSCR 1325
