German arms export policy



Political Principles for the Export of War Weapons and Other Military Equipment:

- **Emphasis on the criteria „Human Rights“**

Respect for human rights in the country of destination and end-use will be given particular weight in decisions on exports of war weapons and other military equipment

Licences for exports of war weapons and other military equipment are generally not granted if there is sufficient suspicion that they will be used for internal repression ... or other persistent and systematic human rights violations

German arms export policy



Political Principles for the Export of War Weapons and Other Military Equipment:

- **Differentiation by recipient country**

EU, NATO and NATO-equivalent countries	Third countries
<p>Arms exports to these countries are in principle not to be restricted unless a restriction is necessary in individual cases for special political reasons.</p> <p>→ Restriction in individual cases</p>	<p>The export of war weapons is not licensed unless special foreign or security policy interests argue in favor of a license in an individual case.</p> <p>→ Export license in individual cases</p>

German arms export policy



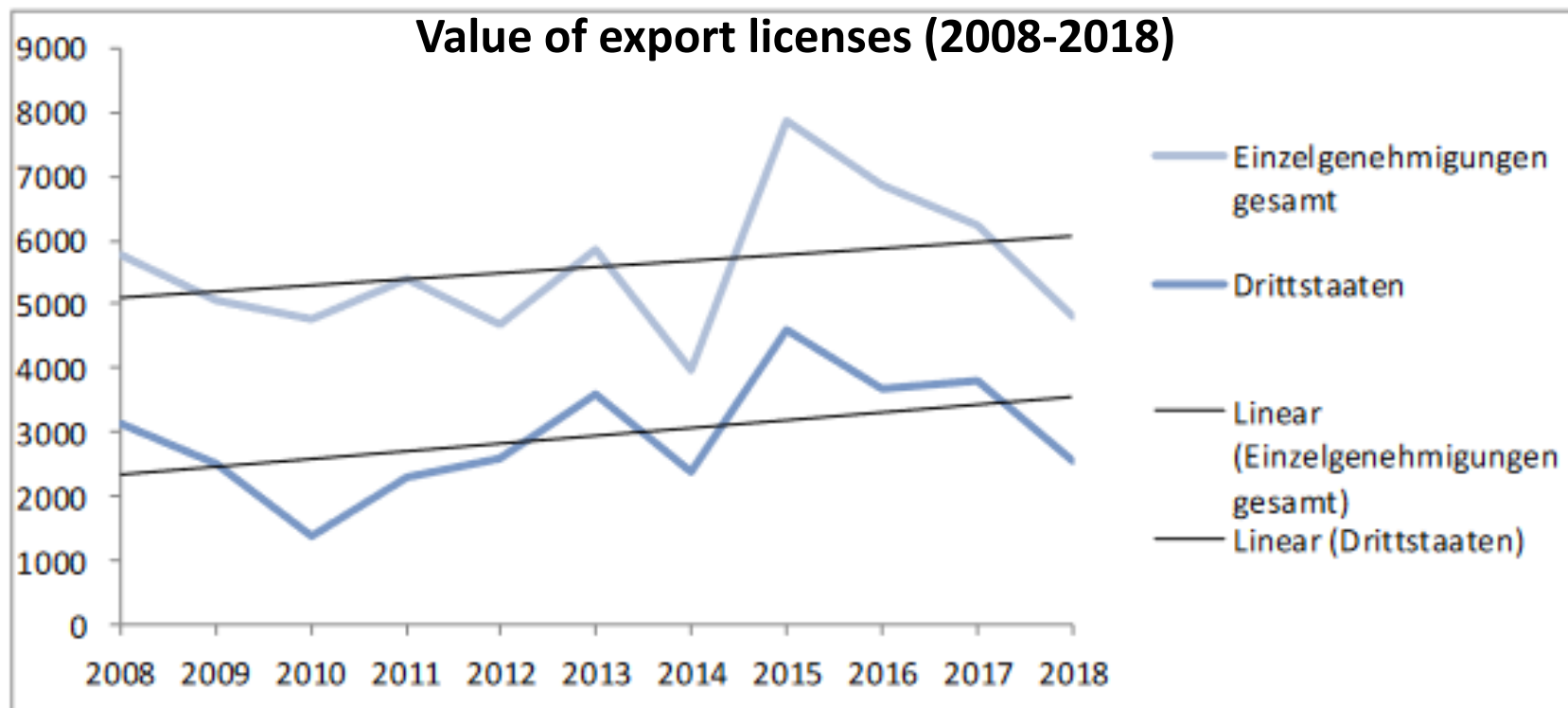
Political Principles for the Export of War Weapons and Other Military Equipment:

- **Differentiation by recipient country: third countries**

The export of war weapons is not authorized in countries,

- that are involved in armed conflict or where there is a threat of armed conflict,
- where there is a threat of armed conflict or where exports would cause, maintain or exacerbate existing tensions and conflicts

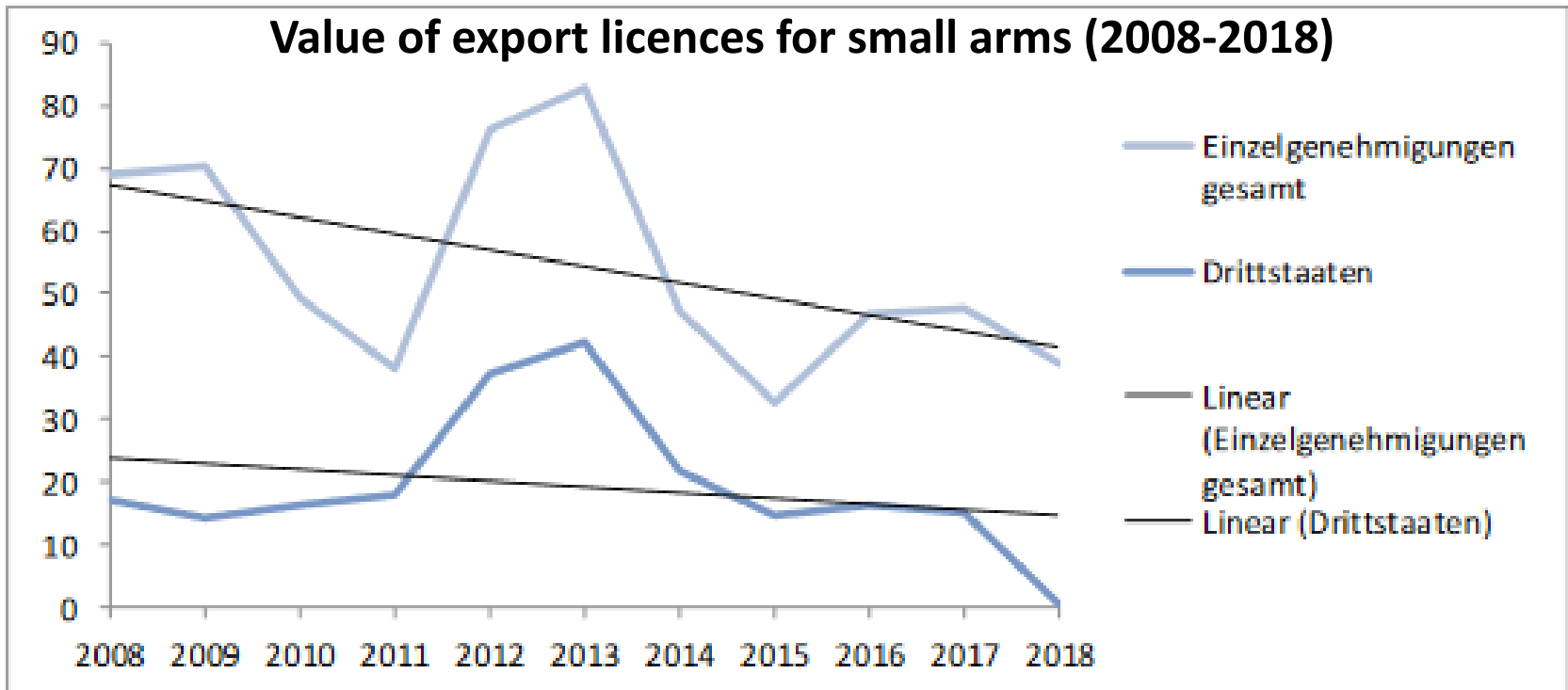

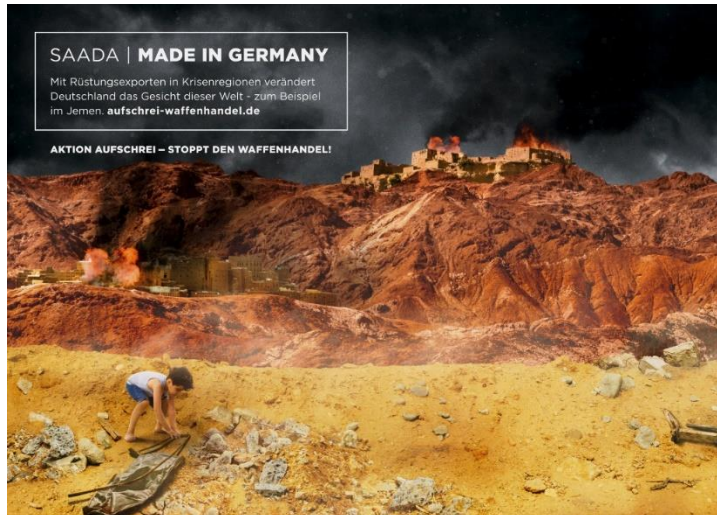
